



Enlaps launches *Planet Watch* by Enlaps on the occasion of the IYGP International Year of Glacier Preservation

Grenoble, March 21, 2025 – Enlaps, a Grenoble-based startup specializing in long-term project monitoring, announces the launch of *Planet Watch by Enlaps*. This ambitious initiative aims to support the scientific community and raise public awareness about the impacts of climate change on glaciers. Enlaps is committed to dedicating 1% of its Tikee timelapse camera sales volume to environmental monitoring.

A technology serving glaciers, acclaimed by scientists

Adopted by many glaciologists, the *Tikee* solution combines a 100% autonomous camera (solar-powered, 4G-connected, GPS-equipped, and resistant to extreme conditions) with the *myTikee* cloud platform. This platform generates high-quality content and provides essential data for analyzing climatic phenomena affecting glacier melt.

Thanks to this ecosystem, scientists can precisely document glacier changes in various locations worldwide, including **Santa Isabel in Colombia**, **Fellaria in Italy**, **Bossons glacier in France**, **Heinabergjökull in Iceland**, and many more.

40 projects per year to better understand climate change

Since COP26, Enlaps has been involved in several glacier monitoring projects. With *Planet Watch by Enlaps*, the ambition is even greater: **10 projects will be selected each quarter**, totalizing **40 projects per year**, to enhance knowledge about climate impacts on key locations worldwide.

A **jury of experts**, including leading figures known for their commitment to climate action – such as Antoine Auberton-Hervé (CEO of Enlaps), Dr. Heidi Sevestre (Glaciologist, speaker, author), and Prof. Dr. Michael Zemp, Director of WGMS (World Glacier Monitoring Service) – will select projects based on scientific and technical criteria.
